

Anti-Dumping Investigation - Extension of time to publish SEF and Final Report

On 17 March 2021 we noted the Anti-Dumping Commission had, on 15 March 2021, initiated an investigation into the alleged dumping of quenched and tempered steel plate exported to Australia from the United States of America.

Due to delays in undertaking further analysis, and to allow sufficient time for consideration of all relevant issues, Justin Wickes, Acting General Manager of the commission, requested a further extension of the deadline for the Commissioner to publish the statement of essential facts (SEF) and provide his final report and recommendation to the Minister.

On 25 January 2022, the Commissioner, under section 269ZHI(3) of the Customs Act 1901 (Cth), extended the due date to publish the SEF and provide his final report and recommendation. The Commissioner is now due to publish the SEF on the public record on or before 31 March 2022. The Commissioner is now due to make a recommendation to the Minister in a final report on or before 25 May 2022.
