Anti-Dumping Investigation - Release of Verification Report

On 17 March 2021 we advised that the Anti-Dumping Commission had, on 15 March 2021, initiated an investigation into the alleged dumping of quenched and tempered steel plate exported to Australia from the United States of America.

We now advise that the Anti-Dumping Commission issued the Importer Verification Report on 1 March 2022. This report provides interested parties with information regarding all material aspects of the verification, including explanations of any material issues identified during the verification. It outlines the nature, extent and consequences of any changes made to the data submitted, including data corrections made by the company or by the verification team.

As previously advised, the Commissioner is due to publish the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) on the public record on or before 31 March 2022. The Commissioner is now due to make a recommendation to the Minister in a final report on or before 25 May 2022.
