Anti-Dumping Investigation – Response to Verification Reports

On 17 March 2021 we advised that the Anti-Dumping Commission had, on 15 March 2021, initiated an investigation into the alleged dumping of quenched and tempered steel plate exported to Australia from the United States of America.

We now advise that on 11 March 2022, Bisalloy submitted a response to the Exporter and Importer Verification Reports.

As previously advised, the Commissioner is due to publish the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) on the public record on or before 31 March 2022. The Commissioner is now due to make a recommendation to the Minister in a final report on or before 25 May 2022.
