1. About this Privacy Policy

1.1 Bisalloy Steel Group Limited (ABN 22 098 674 545) and its related and associated bodies corporate (us, we, our) maintain a policy of strict confidence concerning your (you, your) personal information (Privacy Policy). This Privacy Policy has been developed in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) (Privacy Act). Our strict Privacy Policy governs how we collect, store, use and share your personal information. This Privacy Policy applies to information provided to us by any other means and explains how we will comply with the Australian Privacy Principles under the Privacy Act.

2. Collection of personal information

2.1 The types of personal information Bisalloy will collect from you will depend on the circumstances in which that information is collected. It may include: your name, date of birth, contact details such as current and previous address, telephone numbers, email address, occupation, details of shareholdings, information required for recruitment purposes, information required to open or maintain a trading account with Bisalloy or otherwise do business with us, including your bank account details, information obtained through credit checks, information from prior dealings with Bisalloy and statistical information on the use of the Bisalloy websites, such as your IP address, dates and times of visits.

2.2 We collect personal information through various means including: our websites, use of social media, orders for and provision of products, services or support, employment applications, third party service providers, credit checks, credit assessments and debt recovery actions, warranty claims, feedback from customers, our shareholder registry, responses to surveys or research conducted by us, and entries into competitions or trade promotions.

2.3 If you do not provide us with the information we request, we may not be able to fulfill the applicable purpose of collection, such as to supply products or services to you or to assess your application for employment.

2.4 Where practicable, we will collect personal information directly from you. If we receive information about you from someone else (for example from someone who supplies goods or services to us), we will take reasonable steps to ensure you are aware that we have collected personal information about you and the circumstances of the collection.

3. Use and disclosure of personal information

3.1 Our main purposes for collecting, holding, using and disclosing personal information are to: supply and obtain products or services; respond to enquiries; assess and process warranty claims; assess employment applications; undertake research and surveys, and analyse statistical information; conduct trade promotions; comply with legislation and regulations; comply with our policy requirements including in relation to occupational health and safety, diversity, workers compensation, Fair Work Act and environmental matters; to inform you of changes to our business and our products; and for marketing purposes, including to assist in developing our website.

3.2 We generally explain at the time we collect personal information how we will use or disclose that information. We will only use or disclose personal information for a purpose other than for which it was collected or a related purpose if you have consented to such different use or disclosure or such use or disclosure is otherwise allowed by the Privacy Act.

3.3 In carrying out our business, it may be necessary to share information about you with and between our related bodies corporate and organisations that provide services to us (eg, our business partners).

4. Disclosure of information outside the jurisdiction of collection

We may disclose personal information collected in Australia outside of the jurisdiction. In the conduct of our business, we transfer to, hold or access personal information from various countries outside Australia including New Zealand, China, Thailand and Indonesia.

5. Direct marketing

We may, from time to time, send you marketing materials. If you are receiving promotional information from us and do not wish to receive this information any longer, please contact Bisalloy direct companysecretary@bisalloy.com.au asking to be removed from our mailing lists or use the unsubscribe facilities included in our marketing communications.

6. Our website privacy practices

We sometimes use cookie technology on our websites to provide information and services to website visitors. Cookies are pieces of information that a website transfers to your computer's hard disk for record keeping purposes and are a necessary part of facilitating online transactions. Most web browsers are set to accept cookies. Cookies are useful to estimate our number of members and determine overall traffic patterns through our websites. If you do not wish to receive any cookies you may set your browser to refuse cookies. This may mean you will not be able to take full advantage of the services on the website.

7. Links to other websites

Our websites may contain links to third-party websites. These linked sites are not under our control and we are not responsible for the content of those sites nor are those sites subject to our Privacy Policy. Before disclosing your personal information on any other website we recommend that you examine the terms and conditions and Privacy Policy of the relevant site. Bisalloy is not responsible for any practices on linked websites that might breach your privacy.

8. Accessing and correcting the information we hold about you

8.1 If at any time you want to know exactly what personal information we hold about you, you are welcome to request access to your record by contacting us at companysecretary@bisalloy.com.au. Our file of your information will usually be made available to you within 21 days.

8.2 If at any time you wish to change personal information that we hold about you because it is inaccurate or out of date, please contact us at companysecretary@bisalloy.com.au and we will amend this record. If you wish to have your personal information deleted, please let us know in the same manner as referred to above and we will take all reasonable steps to delete it unless we are legally required to retain it.

9. Contacting Us and complaints

9.2 In most cases we will ask that you put your request in writing to us. We will investigate your complaint and will use reasonable endeavours to respond to you in writing within 30 days of receiving the written complaint.
